Upcycled CD Fish



Supplies:

- Old CDs
- Colored Sharpie markers
- Black fine-stipped Sharpie marker
- Construction paper
- Googly eyes
- String (to hang your fish)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Tape

Instructions:

- **1.** On the shiny side of the CD, color your fish's body in many colors, the more colorful the better, using the colored Sharpies. Let dry.
- 2. Cut a circle out of construction paper to cover the center hole of the CD. Cut a square piece of construction paper and fold it into a fan shape, glue it in the circle to the center of the CD to form a side fin on your fish.
- **3.** Cut top and bottom fins, a tail, and "fish lips" out of the constriction paper and glue them to the CD from the back. Attach the string behind the top fin, if using, to hang the fish in your window or elsewhere.
- 4. Glue the googly eyes to the fish so they can "see".
- 5. Stand back and admire your fish, and use more CDs to make a whole aquarium!
