

Make a Princess Cone Hat



Supplies:

- Construction paper (24" x 36")
- White glue or glue dots
- Transparent tape
- Crepe paper or any sheer paper
- Elastic string (optional)
- Things to decorate your hat: ribbons, fabric, feather boas, sequins, stickers, rhinestones, glitter glue, etc.

Tools:

- Scissors
- Stapler
- Pencil
- Ruler

Instructions:

1. Create a large compass by tying the end of a piece of string around the middle of a pencil. Make sure that the other end of the string all the way to the tip of the pencil is at least 14 to 16 inches long. (Use a longer string if you need a larger cone hat.)
2. Use tape or your thumb to keep the free end of the string on the corner of your construction paper. While pulling tightly, draw an arc from one edge of the paper to the adjacent edge, forming a quarter circle.
3. Cut the paper along the arc and position the quarter circle so that the arc is at the bottom and the tip is on top. Now trim a little bit off the top so you can fit your crepe paper streamers in.
4. Cut several strips of crepe paper or tissue paper in different colors, longer than the height of your hat. Putting one end of them together, wind the ends into a little pencil-shaped bit and tape that to the top of the inside of your hat.
5. Roll your hat into a cone shape and glue it together securely. Staple the elastic string to the bottom as a chin strap.
6. Now decorate your princess hat to be as beautiful as you are!
