

Pool Noodle Horses



Supplies:

- Pool Noodles
- Twine
- Scissors
- Craft foam in two colors
- Googly eyes
- Yarn
- Glue gun & glue sticks

Instructions:

1. Bend about $\frac{1}{4}$ of the pool noodle down to touch the rest of it and use the twine to tie it firmly in place. This will be your horse's head.
2. Cut rounded triangle shapes out of the craft foam in both large and small sizes in contrasting colors. Glue the smaller shape inside the larger shape as shown in the photo above. These will make the horse's ears. Use the hot glue gun to attach them to each side of the top of the horse's head.
3. Cut two round shapes out of the craft foam for the horse's nostrils. Glue one to each side of the bottom of the head.
4. Glue two googly eyes on each side of the horse's head so they can "see"
5. Now make long loops of the yarn, tying them together at one end. Make a small slit in the top of the horse's head and using some hot glue to hold it in, tuck the tied part into that hole. Cut the other end of the loops apart to act as the horse's mane and forelock.
6. Now enjoy riding your horse!
